

HKMA CMS New Features -Wuhan Project between eHealth Record (eHR) Office and The Hong Kong Medical Association

Since the launch of the HKMA Clinic Management System (CMS) 3.0 to all the registered doctors in Hong Kong in August 2009, the no. of users increases steadily. Doctors can now download the upgrade versions from the HKMA website to facilitate better clinic management.

In December 2009, the eHealth Record Office (eHR Office) of the Food and Health Bureau offered a sponsorship to HKMA to enhance the HKMA CMS to Wuhan Version to enable public-private eHealth Record (eHR) sharing. The Wuhan Project includes the development of Integration Hub for medical information exchange, integration of the HKMA CMS with various subsidized healthcare schemes, including the Elderly Health Care Voucher Pilot Scheme and Vaccination Subsidy Schemes, and integration with the Central Notification Office system of the Centre for Health Protection, Department of Health.

After one year's endless effort, HKMA is pleased to announce in this afternoon's Press Conference that the development of Integration Hub was successfully completed. The HKMA CMS users could have a more convenient and efficient clinic workflow when connecting to the electronic platforms for sharing of medical records from now on.

Professor Gabriel LEUNG, JP, Under Secretary for Food and Health attended the press conference this afternoon, expressed that the new features of HKMA CMS and the completion of the development of the Integration Hub symbolized a new milestone in eHR development. It is also a major step for the development of electronic medical information exchange for the private healthcare sector.

Dr. HO Chung Ping, MH, JP, Chairman of the HKMA Information Technology Committee believed the successful completion of the HKMA CMS Integration Hub opened a new mileage of both the medical and information technology industries. It is the first integration server to connect the private practitioners and the public sector and will serve a secure foundation for future development on the territory-wide eHR sharing. It was predicted in the future, more private doctors would adopt the HKMA CMS and participate in the various subsidized healthcare schemes with the completion of the Integration Hub.

香港醫學會自二零零九年八月推出「香港醫學會診所管理 3.0 軟件」予全港的註冊醫生使用以來,使用軟件的醫生數目穩定增長。現時,醫生可從香港醫學會網頁下載升級的軟件版本,以提升診所管理及提供更全面的醫療服務。

二零零九年十二月,食物及衞生局電子健康記錄統籌處撥款資助香港醫學會,提升其診所管理軟件至「武漢版」,以達致公私營界別互通電子健康記錄。「武漢計劃」包括發展整合樞紐促進醫療資訊互通、配合各項政府現時推行的資助計劃,包括長者醫療券試驗計劃及疫苗接種資助計劃、以及與衞生署衞生防護中心的網上中央呈報系統互通。

經過一年的努力,醫學會今午宣佈用作醫療資訊互通的整合樞紐已成功建立。使用該軟件的 醫生日後可以更簡易的方法,連接到上述電子平台,更快捷地完成各項程序。

食物及衞生局副局長梁卓偉教授, JP 亦於下午出席記者會。梁教授認為「香港醫學會診所管理軟件」的最新發展及互通整合樞紐的成功建立,標誌著建立電子健康記錄互通的一個里程碑,亦為私營醫療界別邁向電子化踏出重要的一步。

醫學會資訊科技委員會主席何仲平醫生, MH, JP 認為互通整合樞紐的成功建立,開啟了醫學界及資訊科技界發展的新一頁,這是首個公營醫療體系和私家醫生所共同建立的整合樞紐,並為將來的全港性電子記錄互通系统打好基礎。何醫生相信互通整合樞紐建立後,將會有更多醫生使用「香港醫學會診所管理軟件」及透過電子平台參與政府的各項資助計劃。
